





Boulder Book Store Consignment Policy



Policy Information

- Boulder Book Store takes consignments from Local Authors who reside in the state of Colorado.
- Boulder Book Store will not pay more than 50% for a consignment.
- The handling fee for consignment books is \$35.
- Boulder Book Store will initially take **5 copies of the book**.
- Boulder Book Store agrees to display books for 3 months.
- During that period, Boulder Book Store may contact the consignor to request additional books for sale, and/or to pay the consignor for items sold.
- At the end of the consignment period, Boulder Book Store will send unsold books and payment accrued from sales to an address that the consignor provides.
- Boulder Book Store will dispose of books left for more than 1 month without a valid return address.
- Boulder Book Store will only pay for items sold. Damaged or stolen items are the sole financial responsibility of the consignor.

Promotional Packages:

For \$100 we will:

• Feature your book for at least two weeks on a Main Floor display *Please note it takes 3-4 weeks to be placed on the Main Floor display*

For \$175 we will:

- Feature your book for at least two weeks on a Main Floor display
- Feature your book in our email newsletter
- Present your book on the Local Authors page of our website for at least 60 days
- Enable people to buy online for the entire time your book is in stock at the store

Please note it takes 4-6 weeks to be in the email newsletter & on our website.

You must provide:

- 10 copies of your book
- Review or description of your book in 50-75 words.
- JPEG image of the book cover

Note about the fees: Boulder Book Store handles hundreds of consignments per year. These fees allow us to continue to accept all of the professionally-produced, self-published books from our local authors. Through this program, consignors have the same promotional opportunities that traditional publishers enjoy at Boulder Book Store.
